



In a meeting of the social economic group held this February 22 under the leadership of Yunia Pérez Hernández, Vice Governor of Holguín province, and Juan Miguel Morán Martín in charge of defense affairs, crucial issues for the fight against covid-19 in its current outbreak were discussed.

It was of interest to learn about situations such as the capacities available in the isolation centers, and the potential opening of other places as a preventive measure for new possible contacts of cases.

There are less complicated municipalities such as Cueto, Urbano Noris, Cacocum and Frank País, but Holguín, Gibara, Antilla and Mayarí stand out; although in all of them it is necessary to maintain monitoring and conveniently exploit the available resources, such as premises, transportation, personnel at the disposal of the disciplinary order, among others, said Morán Martín.
