The facility, the second of its kind in the country's eastern region, will process up to a thousand samples a day thanks to its workforce of more than 30 workers, including four doctors, 21 health technologists, four computer technicians and three equipment operators.

"This institution, in which highly competent and committed professionals are working now, is a strength for the country's Health System and, specifically, for the province, as it will make it possible to bring closer the realization of PCR diagnostic tests in real time, which until now were done in other distant territories," said Dr. Amarilis Pupo, director of the Provincial Center of Hygiene, Epidemiology and Microbiology.

She also acknowledged the country's efforts to build it, even though the hardening of the United States blockade is affecting our economy.
