

Holguin analyzes progress made in the province

As part of the activities of the Provincial Government of Holguin, governor Julio Cesar Estupiñan Rodriguez analyzed the Programs and Work Objectives of the 14 Councils of the Municipal Administrations (CAM) of the territory.

At the meeting held at Expo-Holguin trade and fair grounds topics of vital significance for the socio-economic development of the province were evaluated, where the mayors of the CAMs discussed their actions in each of the 76 topics examined.

Thus, the municipalities of Sagua de Tánamo, "Calixto García", Cueto, Antilla and Cacocum showed progress in their management at the end of October.

On the other hand, Banes, Mayarí, "Rafael Freyre" and Gibara should concentrate greater efforts because they have the largest number of programs in regression.

During the meeting they also exchanged on the situation of the processing of the voters' proposals, the results of the system of Attention to the Population, the confrontation to the crime and the illegalities and the hygienic-epidemiological situation, together with the Programs of employment and salary and of Local Development, among others of vital importance for the development of Holguin.
